

Notes/Info

- Reference to pedestrians includes cyclists, personal mobility device users and other path users.
- Pedestrians are required to use a crossing if one is within 20 metres. Otherwise, they need to cross the road by the shortest safe route.
- When passing, in either direction, a school bus that has stopped for the purpose of setting down or picking up children, the required speed limit is 25km/h. This can be signified by flashing yellow lights on the bus. Proceeding with caution is recommended at any time there are children near the road.
